What is GLETS?

GLETS stands for Green Local Exchange Trading System. It is designed to be a bartering system designed around the LETS ideals.

This means no real money needs to change hands, instead this currency can be traded in exchange for goods or services across its membership.

Who can join?

Families or individuals can join. There is no upper age but for individual memberships we are looking for young persons to be 12 or older. Younger persons (anyone under the age of 12years) can join but only through the family membership scheme.

How do I get GLETS?

5 GLETS are initially given when you join. After this they can be gained by either volunteer exchange of services e.g. gardening on our allotments at 10 GLETS an hour or exchanging goods like seeds, fruits and vegetables. Suggested prices enclosed on the table.

The amounts of GLETS owned are stored on a database and GLETS vouchers are issued for exchange by Keyham Green Spaces. These are available subject to what is in members GLETS wallets.

Membership Costs

- 1 year family membership (up to 4 people) £25 or 25 GLETS
- Half year membership £12.50 or 12.50 GLETS
- Individual 1 year membership £15 or 15 GLETS
- Individual Half year membership £7.50 or GLETS
- Half year family membership funded by the lottery (up to 4 people) £12.50
- Individual half year membership funded by the lottery £7.50

*NB the first 150 people to join will get a FREE membership subsidized and funded by the LOTTERY.

First come basis and priority of FREE memberships given to people living in the Keyham area.



Exchange Table of GLETS

Item	Cost in GLETS
Volunteer time	10 GLETS hr
Compost Liquid	1 GLET per ltr
Seeds	1 GLET per 20
Fruit (small)	1 GLET per 5
Fruit (medium)	1 GLET per 2
Fruit (Large)	1 GLET per item
Vegetables (small)	1 GLET per 5
Vegetables (medium)	1 GLET per 2
Vegetables (large)	1 GLET per item

The above is a suggested table only as members may decide on whatever amount of GLETS they wish to charge or exchange for goods or services between themselves.
